“Publishing in Nature Human Behaviour and other Nature portfolio journals”

Abstract : *Nature Human Behaviour is a Nature portfolio journal with the aim to publish research of outstanding significance into any aspect of individual and collective human behaviour. The journal is committed to fostering robust science, and to strengthening the reach and impact of human behavioural sciences.*

What does that mean for readers, authors, and reviewers?

In this presentation, we will discuss the scope and aims of Nature Human Behaviour and how it relates to other journals in the Nature family. I will talk about how the journal's mission shapes its policies and publications. We will discuss the editorial processes at Nature Human Behaviour and the other Nature portfolio journals (including Nature, Nature Neuroscience, the Communications journals and Scientific Reports): what do editors look for in the papers we want to publish, how do we make decisions? I will provide some tips on how to write a paper for submission to Nature Human Behaviour and other Nature Research journals, and explain your options during peer-review and at publication.
