The lecture will be held by Dr. David S. Zee, Professor of Neurology at John Hopkins University School of Medicine, Baltimore, MD. He is a world's leading expert on vertigo, ataxia, and disorders of eye movements. Dr. Zee holds joint academic appointments in the Departments of Ophthalmology and Otorhinolaryngology. His research focus is on learning and adaption in patients with vertigo, combining methodology and expertise from his backgrounds as a bioengineer and experimental physiologist. He has authored more than 400 peer-reviewed research articles and has served on the editorial boards of a number of top-ranking journals such as Brain and Annals of Neurology.

The Swiss Neurology Webinars are interactive web-based lectures that take place six times a year.
