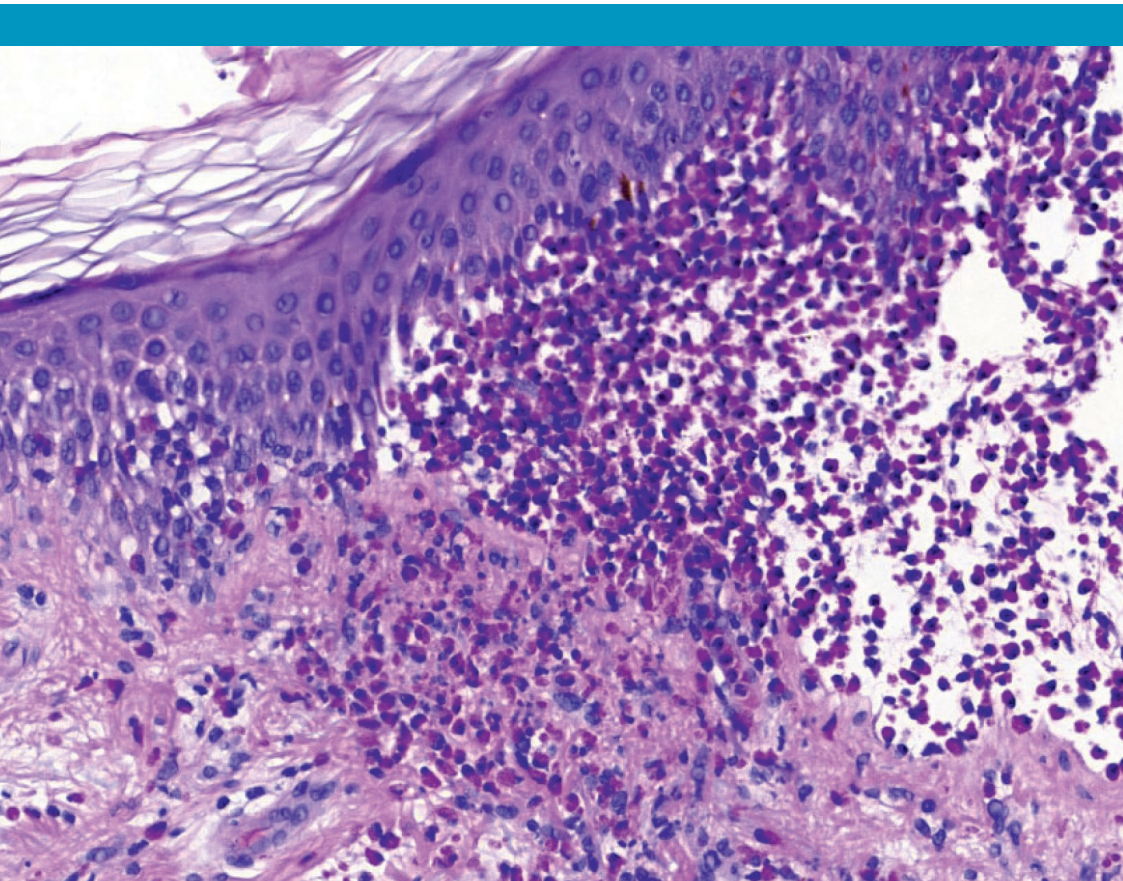


A PRACTICAL APPROACH TO THE DIAGNOSIS OF INFLAMMATORY DISEASES OF THE SKIN
