COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course focuses on preparing policymakers and professionals in health-related fields to navigate complex global health policy, advocacy, and diplomacy.

It covers topics, such as global health governance, health and foreign public policy making in global health, advocacy methods and strategies for health and intersectoral approaches to health policy and advocacy.

The program extends over a five-day period, incorporating lectures, a simulation exercise, case studies, and visits to prominent organizations.

Participants have the opportunity to earn 3 ECTS credits by reflecting on simulation exercises and key learnings. The objective is to empower attendees with essential skills for active participation in the changing realm of global health policy and advocacy.

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
